PONY CLUB POWER QUIZZING, May 8

The pony clubbers will be tested on Health Veterinary Knowledge – Illness & wound. You will be tested on the materials presented in April by Allie and Becca PLUS materials from the D and C manuals. All Ds should read pages 209 to 216. C1s should read pages 205-241.

The standard reads:

- D1- Discuss what a veterinarian is. Give one reason the vet might treat your pony.
- D2- Give two reasons to have your pony routinely checked by a veterinarian.
- D3- Name some symptoms of a sick or injured pony that would cause you to seek help.
- C1- Describe how to treat minor wounds. Discuss regular worming control for own mount; how and why to deworm new mounts in barn. Know health care schedule for own mount including dates of inoculations (tetanus, encephalomyelitis, etc.), deworming, floating of teeth, shoeing.

ACTIVITY BUDGET (or why we need to raise more funds!)

Lakefield uses club funds to support regional competitions/activities such as Mega Rally, D Rally and summer camp. The club pays one half of the fees for these events. According to the interest survey taken last month the club will spent approx. \$2,870 on these three events. The club also supports several social functions such as Pony Prom, Halloween Games Day and the Holiday/Awards party. It is estimated these three events will cost \$1,500. The total activity budget is \$4,370. The club currently has a \$4,900 checking account balance.
