### **PONY CLUB POWER QUIZZING, June 12**

The pony clubbers will be tested on Breeds. You will be tested on the materials presented in May by Lexi and Julianna, PLUS materials from the D manual. All Ds should read pages 232-234 and 240-243. There is no C standard for this topic.

The standard reads:

D1- D2- Name four horse or pony breeds.

D3- Describe the characteristics of a strange pony clearly enough for another person to recognize it within a group. Include: color, breed, markings, size, sex and obvious conformation characteristics.
